Member Incentives **Some restrictions and limitations apply to Member Incentives. Each member can earn up to \$250 in cash and non-cash goods and services each year, with the year running from July 1st to June 30th.	<p>Care Card Rewards for Healthy Behaviors to use to purchase baby care items, healthy foods and more.
