<b>Family Care Plan</b>  <b>Video Update &amp; Dissemination</b>  <b>Binder Pilot Project</b>	<p><b>Updates on Family Care Plan/Plan of Safe Care:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Two web pages will be created to host POSC content for families and providers. The provider content will be hosted on the Center for Excellence website and the family content will be on the Today is For Me website but a vanity url, NHFamilyCarePlan.org will be used.</li></ul> <p><b>Family Care Plan Video Update and Dissemination</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>The goal of these videos is to start conversations between families and providers.</li><li>The provider and family promotional videos have been finalized.</li><li>Dissemination will take place shortly.</li><li>QR codes will be shared for families and providers.</li><li>15-30 second versions will be used for radio, tv, and/or social media.</li><li>Video suggestions received from participants include:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Capitalize DCYF and POSC</li><li>Remove pacifier, if possible</li></ul></li></ul> <p><b>Binder Pilot Project</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>NH will be pilot testing the binder approach with two participating organizations.</li><li>This approach was first implemented by the state of Texas followed by Oklahoma and New Mexico.</li><li>The content for the binder has been drafted as well as an implementation guide.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>JSI will send a request to ask that providers share the video with their colleagues/net works as well as with patients.</li></ul>



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ JSI is waiting to receive final feedback from the participating organizations.</li><li>○ The pilot will be for four months (November-February).</li><li>○ Once feedback is received, these changes will be made before full implementation.</li></ul>	
<b>DCYF Community Response Guide &amp; Community Navigator Program</b>	<p><b>DCYF Community Response Guide</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● The Community Response Guide is a web-based tool for reporters and families</li><li>● The tool uses four guides for decision making: equity, accuracy, consistency, utility.</li><li>● 5 different design phases were used to develop the Community Response Guide<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ 1) Convening of community core team</li><li>○ 2) Reviewing statutes, policies, practices, data. Hearing from the community about what this process should look like.</li><li>○ 3) Designing actual tool and testing it</li><li>○ 4) Implement</li><li>○ 5) Result</li></ul></li><li>● Helps reporters make concrete decisions about when to report. Reporters put information into the response guide and will be given different options based on what they entered.</li></ul> <p><b>Community Navigator Program</b></p> <p>Why?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● The Community Navigator Program allows families to be connected to services without being fully connected to DCYF.</li><li>● The hope is that the Community Response Guide and Community Navigator will work together to help families more easily access resources.</li><li>● When using the Community Response Guide one of the options is getting connected to the Community Navigator.</li></ul>	



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Target Population for the Community Navigator Program:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>◦ Pregnant person</li><li>◦ Primary caregivers under age of 26</li><li>◦ Child in household under age of three</li><li>◦ Non-parental caregiver as legal guardian</li></ul></li><li>• 2 Main Outcomes for the Community Navigator Program:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>◦ Provide outreach and education for reporters by giving them the information they need</li><li>◦ Provide the skills or resources to families to give them more information</li></ul></li><li>• The Community Navigator Program Process:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Referral and outreach to reporter</li><li>2. Engage reporter and provide info on program and community resources (within 24 hrs)</li><li>3. Reporter works with family to provide support</li><li>4. If reporter does not want to engage with family then community navigator will engage and reach out to family</li></ol></li></ul>	
<b>New Grant Activities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Grant for NH Charitable Foundation will be ending in November. It will be renewed for another year.</li><li>• Funds will be used to support quarterly meetings, technical assistance, training, and continued implementation of the binder project.</li><li>• Discussed potential of hosting a POSC summit for people working with families.</li></ul>	
<b>2024 Meeting Schedule</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No additional meetings have been scheduled. Meetings will be scheduled once the funds have been secured for the next project period.</li></ul>
