Update on NH's State Plan Amendment	<ul> <li>Perinatal Substance Exposure Collaborative Updates</li> <li>Changes in the Medicaid Budget</li> <li>Medicaid now offers doula services, lactation services and breastmilk</li> <li>Effective date was October 1st, 2023—this is the day these services can be billed for</li> <li>12 month of continuous coverage for all services</li> <li>Continuous coverage means that birthing people will remain eligible regardless of changes in income</li> </ul>
	Reporting on Continuous Coverage
	<ul> <li>Commissioner to submit reports to Dept. of Health and Human Services</li> <li>Medicaid/CHIP has also expanded continuous coverage for lawfully residing Pregnant Women and Children</li> </ul>
	Doula Service Updates
	<ul> <li>You can get a waiver to support doula services under Medicaid</li> <li>Reporting is due to start January of next year</li> <li>What constitutes Doula Services?</li> <li>Lots of questions about who the doula can work for, what their qualifications are, and what doula means in the prenatal education realm. No specifics yet</li> </ul>
	Lactation Services
	<ul> <li>New state plan approval document includes breastfeeding education, assessment related to breastfeeding</li> <li>Lactation service providers might vary</li> <li>Legislation also allows for donor breast milk services</li> </ul>
	<ul><li>Donor breast milk has been categorized as durable medical equipment</li><li>Donor breast milk eligibility is varied and unclear in</li></ul>

Family Care Planner Update	<ul> <li>Pilot tests 20 binders at Dartmouth and 5 at Concord</li> <li>Some concern over whether or not patients will actually bring the binder in to appointments</li> <li>Concern over patients leaving binders somewhere else and it being a privacy concern</li> <li>Gotten some feedback that web based app would be helpful and could resolve some of the privacy concerns however identifying funds to support this work has been challenging.</li> <li>Visit <a href="https://nhcenterforexcellence.org/posc/">https://nhcenterforexcellence.org/posc/</a> for more information about NH's Family Care Plan and the pilot project.</li> </ul>
