Meeting Summary

- The new rules regarding a 1/3 quorum were reviewed and implemented for the first half of the meeting.
- Jill Burke shared an update on the Financial Dashboard and requested feedback on her recommendations. She also recommended that a quarterly programmatic dashboard be created to complement the Financial Dashboard.
- As of March, the Liquor Commission estimates that 5% of revenue for FY23 would be \$10.7K. It remains to be seen what the final number will be.
- The co-chairs shared a debrief of the Governor's Commission meeting in December, where the final budget, including much of the Budget Task Force's recommendations, was approved.
- Budget Task Force priorities for 2024 were discussed.

Decisions/Recommendations Made

- 1. Minutes from the November Budget Task Force meeting were approved.
- 2. Budget Task Force priorities for 2024 identified were as follows: continuing to hone in on funding reductions and how DHHS is planning to address them; continuing to work on the Funding Crosswalk and add other funding streams to it; and developing a process for unencumbered and carry-forward dollars.
