2023 NSDUH Data on Behavioral Health of LGB+ Youth

The National Survey on Drug Use and Health (NSDUH) has released new data pertaining to Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and any non-heterosexual identifying youth. The data highlighted in a new infographic report indicates LGB+ youth are more likely than straight youth to experience mental health issues and serious suicidal thoughts.



Monitoring Drug Street Names Added to DAWN For First Time

The Substance Abuse & Mental Health Services Administration's Drug Abuse Warning Network (DAWN) has added drug street names to their database. This improves communication, awareness and understanding of drug slang and helps identify substance misuse while avoiding misunderstandings related to substances involved in street drugs.

New SAMHSA Issue Brief: Co-Occurring Mental Health and Substance Use

The Substance Abuse & Mental Health Services Administration's (SAMHSA) new issue brief provides information on designing more efficient and accessible service delivery options for people with co-occuring disorders.

Data Released on Substance Use and Mental Health Treatment Facilities

The National Substance Use and Mental Health Services Survey 2023: Data on Substance Use and Mental Health Treatment Facilities has released its annual report covering key operational characteristics of substance use disorder and mental health treatment facilities, use of pharmacotherapies, and language and suicide prevention assistance services.
