Early Care for a Healthy Start

Studies show that women who receive early, regular care before baby arrives (prenatal care) are healthier and have healthier babies. With regular prenatal care, you can:

- Watch your baby's growth
- Identify any health issues early
- Get to know your medical providers
- Ask questions and get important emotional support

After Your Baby Arrives

Caring for your body and mind after pregnancy (postpartum) is key to your health and well-being, allowing you to be there for your little one. **Postpartum care is now covered by Medicaid for 12 months after your baby is born.** During postpartum healthcare visits, you can:

- Get support during a time of physical and emotional change
- Learn about feeding and infant care
- Ask any questions you have about family planning

If you have Medicaid coverage through a Managed Care Organization (MCO):

Reach out to your Medicaid MCO (AmeriHealth Caritas, NH Healthy Families, or WellSense) as soon as you know you're pregnant.
